

**IMPORTANT NOTICE**

**Subject: • Exemption from appearing in Typing Test/Skill Test of Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination, 2025 (Tier-II) for PwD candidates - regarding.**

As per Para No. 13.8.13.7 (vii) of Recruitment Notice of Combined Higher Secondary (10+2) Level Examination, 2025, "Persons with Disabilities candidates who claim to be permanently unfit to take the Typing Test because of a physical disability may, with the prior approval of the Commission, be exempted from the requirement of appearing and qualifying at such test, provided such a candidate submits a Certificate in the prescribed format (**Annexure-XIV**) to the Commission from the competent Medical Authority, i.e., the Civil Surgeon of a Government Health Care Institution declaring him to be permanently unfit for the Typing Test because of a physical disability. In addition, such candidates must substantiate their claim by furnishing the relevant Medical Certificate in the prescribed format as per **Annexure-XI to Annexure-XIII** of the Notice of Examination, as applicable, at the time of Typing Test. Otherwise their claim for seeking exemption from Typing Test will not be entertained by the Commission."

2. In terms of above provisions, the PwD candidates qualified from Western Region seeking exemption from appearing in Typing Test may, in their own **interest**, send a request along with scanned copies of following documents to the email address: **examinquirysscwr@gmail.com**, latest by **31.03.2026**:

(i) Medical Certificate seeking exemption in prescribed format (Annexure XIV of the notice of Examination) from the Competent Medical Authority, i.e., the Civil Surgeon of a Government Health Care Institution. It is again reiterated that candidates submitting Annexure-XIV should ensure that the certificate has the following:

- (a) Issued by Civil Surgeon.
- (b) Clearly indicate how the disability interferes with Typewriting/Skill Test.
- (c) Brief description of disabilities.
- (d) Percentage of disabilities

(ii) Undertaking as per the format annexed to this notice.

3. The decision of the competent authority on grant of exemption will be conveyed to the candidate on or before the day of Typing Test.

4. The candidates are required to produce all these documents in original before the Commission/Indenting User Department, as and when sought during Document Verification or otherwise.

5. PLEASE NOTE:

- (i) Skill Test for DEOs is mandatory for all the qualified candidates. Typing Test for posts other than DEOs is mandatory for all candidates except those who are exempted from appearing in the Typing Test as per Para 13.9.13.7. (vii).
- (ii) HH and VH candidates are not eligible for exemption from the Typing Test.
- (iii) No exemption from Computer Knowledge Test is allowed for any category of PwD candidates.
